A New MP3 Player: The Galet

AUDIO VIE FRANCE continues to invest in developing new MP3 players to promote listening to the audio Bible, along with other uplifting and evangelistic recordings. Our goal remains the same: to offer compact, simple, reliable, and user-friendly devices at an affordable price, ensuring they can be widely distributed across mission fields.

This guiding principle shaped the design of our new audio player: **The Galet** (french for “Pebble”, pronouce gah-leh). We chose this name not only because of its oval shape —reminiscent of a smooth river stone— but also in reference to Jesus’ words in Luke 19:40:

“If they keep quiet, the stones will cry out!”

These words are especially meaningful when we consider that these devices are primarily distributed in places where God’s Word is silenced —whether because of restricted religious freedom or simply because there are no evangelists able to communicate it in the heart languages of the people they long to reach.

Technology is becoming a partner in proclaiming God’s Word!

The Galet – What's New



Direct Access

In the small world of audio Bible manufacturers, we are the only ones offering a user experience comparable to opening a printed Bible directly to the chapter you want.

With our devices, this direct access is made possible through a simple 4-digit code entered on the numeric keypad **XXYY**, where:

- **XX** is the code for the biblical book (the full list is printed on a credit-card-sized reference card included with the player —see photo below)
- **YY** is the chapter number

For example, the code for Isaiah is **35**, so to start listening to Isaiah chapter **53**, you simply enter: **3553**.

(A simple trick exists for the book of Psalms which contains 150 chapters...)

Sequential Access

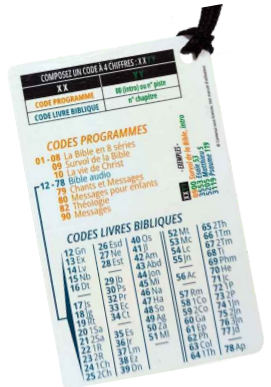
This feature is especially helpful for visually impaired users, who can enjoy the same level of convenience as sighted users. It's also extremely practical when you want to let someone from another country listen to a specific Bible chapter in their own language —without any confusion— because the coding system is identical across all languages.

But there is another audience —less educated or even illiterate— who may feel intimidated by a numeric keypad and prefer an approach that is less efficient but even simpler. That's why the Galet is our very first player to offer, in addition to direct access, a **fully sequential navigation** system with dedicated previous/next buttons for both chapters and books.

Although the Galet is designed to function as an audio Bible, its actual use depends entirely on the microSD card inserted. The device itself is presented simply as a generic audio book player. Its internal advantage is that **it can hold a second microSD card**, connected internally. Switching between the internal and external cards is done at will by entering a **secret key combination**.

This allows someone to listen discreetly to the Bible through headphones while appearing to listen to the Qur'an or any other secular content. Even if the Galet were discovered by someone else, it would not raise suspicion.



Mission Camp 2026: One Week to Dive into Mission



AUDIO VIE FRANCE is co-organizing the 10th edition of 'Mission Camp' in Sicily, taking place from July 17 to 24. This international camp is open to everyone (18+) who desires to get involved and discover mission work, with a special focus on evangelism and serving foreigners and refugees.

The program includes teaching sessions, hands-on training with missionaries, and local outreach activities to connect with the community. There will also be times for sharing, relaxation, and exploring the region.

News from Asia

AUDIO VIE FRANCE Expands its presence in Southeast Asia.

A Bible society in a *sensitive country* has already purchased 500 customized Galet players, branded in their colors, to distribute their new contemporary-language Bible translation. Depending on the results of this initiative, annual orders of several thousand Galet players are expected to follow.

In *Pakistan*, evangelistic campaigns are being carried out through Facebook, using sponsored ads specifically designed to reach local populations. These campaigns generate nearly one million clicks per month and have already led to baptisms through connections with local partners.

In *India*, significant evangelistic work is growing across many states, particularly among the Dalits.

Our local representative promoted our work at a mission fair in Korea and established promising contacts with international mission organizations for future partnerships.

We will also take part in the EMDC conferences in Thailand to present our products (the new Galet player and the updated BEAMER bush projector, now in its *Neo* revision). This will be an opportunity to invite our regional field leaders and strengthen our fellowship together.

Seminar in Chad

Daniel ODDON was able to travel to *Chad* to lead a seminar with our local partners, equipping and training team members who serve among people groups that have not yet been reached with the Gospel.

Participants traveled from all across the country to attend the seminar. They work among completely unreached peoples or among ethnic minorities who need ongoing support and encouragement



Training Seminar in Guinea

Daniel and Sylviane were able to travel to Labé in *Guinea-Conakry* to lead a training seminar for a group of Fulani pastors who came from across the country as well as from four neighboring nations. The topics included: facing persecution, sharing the Gospel with unreached tribes using audio and video tools, and teaching the Gospel to children. They also had the opportunity to visit a prison and present the Gospel there.

Labé is a significant city for the Fulani people—a strategic nomadic group for mission work, present across several countries in West and Central Africa.

Exploratory Trip to Armenia

In February, AUDIO VIE FRANCE traveled to southern *Armenia*, near the Iranian border. There, we were able to meet refugees from *Iran* and from Nagorno-Karabakh and share the Gospel with them using our tools. This mission —carried out just before the recent escalation of tensions in the region— now appears even more essential, as further population movements are expected.
